
# What would you do if HMRC investigate your Trust?

HMRC actively target areas where they believe tax is at risk and they use sophisticated software to analyse a huge range of data sources to identify anomalies that lead to an enquiry. There are also enquiries that result from HMRC actively encouraging members of the public to report taxpayers via their hotline and they also continue to carry out some random enquiries.
